


### **Become our next National Diversity Council Certified Diversity Professional (NDCCDP)**

Cecilia Orellana-Rojas, Ph.D. SVP - Strategy & Research National Diversity Council Recertification of the NDCCDP credential is a continuous process, and it occurs every three years. This process begins on the date the NDCCDP credential was awarded.

**Step One** 

Submit the annual maintenance fee of \$40 within one year from graduation date. You can also pay \$120 for the three-year maintenance fee. For example, if your graduation date is 10.11.22, your recertification fee of \$40 is due by 10.11.23.

**Step Two** 

Register and engage in the free pre-recorded Trends and Predictions Webinar offered annually.

**Step Three** 

Register and participate in the required Recertification Workshop every three years.

**Step Four** 

Complete a total of 40 hours of continuing education focused on the four pillars of recertification, which include leadership, collaboration, innovation, and service.

**Step Five** 

Add an entry per activity for the 40 hours of continuing education into your Journal Entries.

40 CE hours will be awarded for the following activities. Proof of documentation must be submitted in PDF or JPEG format.

#### **Trends & Predictions Webinar**
